The board discussed the 1% drop in valuations. Even with the drop in valuations the board will be asking for \$114,000.00 less from the taxpayers for the next budget year. The asking tax rate for the upcoming budget year will be .593702 down from .593953 last budget year. At 7:36 the hearing was closed.

All those in attendance recited the Pledge of Allegiance. Mrs. Coffey acknowledged the meeting notice was posted as required as is the Nebraska Open Meetings Act. Miller moved to approve the agenda. Johnson seconded the motion. All votes were yes. (All votes will be roll call votes unless otherwise stated.) Swartzendruber moved to approve the consent agenda. Noel seconded the motion. The consent agenda contained the previous meeting minutes, treasurer's report, and presentation of claims. All votes were yes.

President Mick welcomed the visitors. There were no public comments.

Discussion items: Administrative report: Superintendent Coffey reported that the window replacement has been completed as well as the removal of asphalt and replacement of concrete on the playground.
